A. Elsa Campos: Having Difficult Conversations

The goal of this workshop is to teach practical skills for communication and creating a structure for having difficult conversations when they arise; creating self awareness for your own discomfort when having challenging conversations, and what you can do to diffuse and manage conflict. Come prepared to talk about your own experiences and participate in working through having difficult conversations.

B. Anna Kirova: RAISED Between Cultures

The RAISED Between Cultures model outlines six important factors that when considered by educators both together and independently, can contribute to children's outcomes, and which make up the RAISED acronym: **R**eveal culture, **A**cknowledge pre-migration experiences, **I**dentify post-migration systemic barriers, **S**upport family and community strengths, **E**stablish connections between environments, and **D**etermine child outcomes together with families.

C. Lynsey Anderson: Coaching Educators to Create a Responsive Environment

Would you like to see positive changes in your dayhome environments? Do you need ideas on how to motivate your Educators to make these changes and engage children? This interactive workshop will provide concrete ideas on how to evaluate the dayhome environment and how to use reflective practice with your Educators to achieve these goals.
